REFERENDUM**

LOCAL OPTION ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER OR NOT THE LEGAL TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE, SALE, DISTRIBUTION, RECEIPT AND/OR MANUFACTURE OF WINE, LIGHT SPIRIT PRODUCT AND BEER SHALL BE PERMITTED IN LAMAR COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI PURSUANT TO TITLE 67 CHAPTER 3 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE ANNOTATED.

You may vote either FOR or AGAINST permitting the legal transportation, storage, sale, distribution, receipt and/or manufacture of wine of an alcoholic content of not more than five percent (5%) by weight, light spirit product of an alcoholic content of not more than six percent (6%) by weight and beer of an alcoholic content of not more than eight percent (8%) by weight in Lamar County, Mississippi.
